



Some notes about Collections, WordBanks and Words in WordCard Generator 2

A WordList can contain words selected from any number of WordBanks and Collections.

In addition to the many built-in WordBanks, you can create your own custom WordBanks containing words of your choice, including words not listed in the supplied WordBanks. While you may type in extra words, it is so easy to copy and paste an existing list you may have prepared earlier in any program, or downloaded from the Internet. All custom WordBanks are stored in the 'Your Own WordBanks' Collection.

Generally WordBanks are in alphabetical order, although occasionally linked words may be out of sequence, e.g. *fit / unfit*. Words are often grouped according to 'rime', e.g. in the *-nt* WordBank, *ant* words will be grouped together (alphabetically), followed by *ent* words, then *int*, etc.

Most lists, however basic the phoneme, will contain 1-syllable words at the beginning and multi-syllabic words at the end to allow for differentiation within the classroom. Where a list contains different sounds, words are grouped according to sound, e.g. *bought / cough*.

The WordBanks try to have regard to regional pronunciation differences, such as in *last* and *bath*, and different teaching techniques, such as 'y' at the end of *happy* - is it 'long e' or 'short i'?

In these WordBanks *-ise* has been used instead of *-ize*, if you have a preference to 'z' you can edit the words and save as your own list.

It is very easy to add your own Meanings to any words. There are only a few WordBanks with meanings included - this is to give you some to try out. Clearly, meanings may change depending on the age and ability of the student (consider using the word match with a young footballer or an adult smoker!)

Some WordBanks contain 'related' words in the Meaning section, e.g. words in the Plurals, Linked Words and Apostrophes Collections. This is to allow you to create activities such as 'Pairs' (Pelmanism), Dominoes, etc., where *wife* is matched to *wives*; the verb appear to the noun appearance; *they'd* to *they would*.

WordCard Generator 2 contains over 17,000 words grouped into over 450 structured WordBanks in 23 Collections. The Collections and WordBanks, along with a small selection of words to illustrate the contents of each, are listed below.
